Taxi Driving Course



We have teamed up with Lancaster City Council to bring you The Introduction to the role of the Taxi & Private Hire Driver training course. This is a compulsory course if you wish to become a Taxi Driver in the Lancaster and Morecambe districts.

What does the course involve?

A **pre-course knowledge test** consisting of 45 questions. This takes place at Lancaster & Morecambe college and **must be passed** prior to being enrolled on the 2-day course.

Once the knowledge test has been completed and successfully passed you will be able to book onto the **2-day course** that is **delivered at Lancaster & Morecambe college**.

The course requires the delegate to complete 6 units:

Unit 1 – Health & Safety

Unit 2 – Road Safety When Driving Passengers

Unit 3 – Professional Customer Service

Unit 4 – Regulatory Framework

Unit 5 – Services for passengers that require assistance

Unit 6 – CSE & Safeguarding

Each unit comes with a **multiple choice exam** to test your knowledge. All units must be completed and passed to complete the course.

How to book a course?

If you would like a place on the course, you must follow these steps:

• Read the **Private Hire and Hackney Carriage licensing policy** on the Lancaster City council website, paying particular attention to application standards set out in section 4. You can email **employerhub@lmc.ac.uk** or **licensing@lancaster.gov.uk** for further information

- Apply for an enhanced DBS certificate these are facilitated by Taxi Plus on Behalf of Lancaster City Council, and you are required to fill in an application
- Contact Lancaster & Morecambe College to book your Pre-Course knowledge test
- Complete the 2-day Taxi Course and obtain your certification

Once you have completed your Taxi Course you will be referred to Lancaster City Council to complete the remaining licensing documentation.

Course Costs

- Delegates who are 19+ and are employed earning over £25,000/year will have to pay a contribution of £50
- Delegates who are 19+ and either Unemployed or earning under £25,000/year are fully funded
